Artist Biography

Aaron Hamilton was born in 1977, in the 'Culture Capital of Dominica', the South-eastern village of Grand Bay. At an early age, he moved to the north-eastern village of Concord where he was raised. A place known for the lush interior passage and constant running waters of one of Dominica's bigger and longer rivers, the Pagua River. This was the fertile ground which surrounded him with vibrancy, peace and beauty, a constant in his paintings, which leaves viewers inspired by his vivid imagery and striking detail.

Hamilton's passion for creating art started at a young age. He is a self-taught artist who possesses a keen eye and a desire to improve his skills. Through his association with Earl Darius Etienne, a renowned artist in Dominica, and other colleagues over the years, he has gained much knowledge. Hamilton's primary medium is acrylic on canvas, but he also enjoys experimenting with other media. He specializes in realistic depictions of landscapes and portraits, as well as capturing cultural scenes that feel immersive and textured. Hamilton's exceptional expertise and skill are unmistakable.

Throughout the year, Hamilton is regularly showcased in various group exhibitions. As the Senior Officer and primary Visual Arts instructor at the Dominica Institute for the Arts located in the Old Mill Cultural Centre, he has organized multiple exhibitions that have provided opportunities for Dominica's most talented artists, including himself, to gain exposure.

Over the years, Hamilton's illustrations have been included in publications such as 'Mwen sé Donmnik', 'Timtim Glo Doubout', 'Mi Bredeks', and 'Ti Listwe Donmnik', a collection of creole expressions and short stories published by Dominica's Konmite pou E'tid Kweyol (KEK). Aaron Hamilton currently serves as Vice President of Dominica's network of artists, 'The Waitukubuli Artist Association'.

Hamilton is deeply dedicated to the Dominica Institute of the Arts, where he imparts his knowledge of Art to students of different levels and ages. He has a strong desire to promote the arts in his nation and hopes to change the way people perceive art and artists in a small island developing state.
